SCHOOL COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING

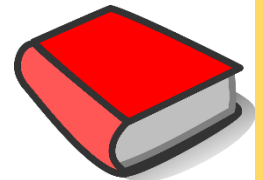

Here is some of the work being done...

MANDATORY MASK USE

Masks must be worn by all students and staff inside the school.

MINIMIZING SCHOOL ACCESS

We must minimize the number of people accessing the school. School access is for M.J. Coldwell students, staff and Regina Public School Personnel only.

If school access is necessary, visitors must call the front office (306)791-8563 prior to entering the school. We are also in the process of installing a doorbell for greater convenience.

Staff will greet visitors outside the front door. When visitors enter the building, they must sign in for purposes of contact tracing.



HAND SANITATION

Scent-free hand sanitizer is provided.

Frequent hand washing procedures are important and necessary.



CLASSROOM COHORTS

Students will continue to be with their classmates in their designated classroom during instructional times.

Transitions inside the school have been minimized during the instructional day.



ADJUSTED SCHOOL DAY

The adjusted school day continues to accommodate student transitions and recesses.

PLAYGROUND ACCESS

Every effort is being made to minimize the number of people on the school playground and tarmac.

Please arrange meeting points for student pick-up and drop-off along the perimeter of the school grounds.

ASSIGNED ENTRANCES

Students are assigned specific entrances to assist with the flow in and out of the building.

PRE-K & K students use the front entrance.

Remaining students must resist using the front entrance.
