

As a parent/guardian, you will be able to use Edsby to keep up with what's happening with your child at school, and help you continue to be an active participant in your child/ren's education. When fully implemented, Edsby will allow parents/caregivers to:

- See academic information (grades, assignments, learning portfolios) about your child/ren, as they are
- posted, in real time.

- notifications.
 Communicate and engage with your child's teacher and school administration staff.
- View and communicate your child's attendance information.
